



○ Tuesday

But the most important day, is the Tuesday. It is called the day of the egg (el día del huevo). This day, the quintos and quintas and all boys and girls smaller than quintos go house to house asking for an egg.

Many people give more than one egg, and somebody only gives it to the quintos and say "today, the chickens don't put egg". It is because in the past, only asking for an egg the quintos. (And many ancient people don't want that the

quintas go with the quintos asking for the egg).

The little boys and girls put the egg in a basket with straw, and then they eat together potato omelette and other foods with eggs.

The quintos take a dumb with a cart to put the eggs, and they eat together too.

In the afternoon, los quintos burn a doll full of straw and firecrackers. (Is important to say, that This doll has a name).

○ Wednesday

This day, all people go to "el entierro de la sardina". This is a funeral procession with a sardine. Everybody can dress up things associates to funeral. The quintos dress up like widows and the quintas dress up like gravediggers.

Furthermore, there are more things but it isn't traditional, like a play to the children (almost all with eggs) and other parties in the discos to the adults. (All organized by the quintos and quintas).
