

DUBLIN

Dublin is capital of Ireland and is known in Irish as *Baile Átha Cliath* (meaning "town of the hurdled ford"), and its name in English comes for the Irish *Dubh Linn* meaning black pool.

Dublin is the largest city in Ireland with around half a million of people living there

Most important streets are O'Connell Street, Henry Street and Grafton Street

The Spire is called Monument of Light and it's in O'Connell Street, and has 120 meters in height

Molly Malone's Statue is where people meet one each other. Is at the beginning of Grafton Street.

Trinity College is the most famous university in Dublin, and in its library is the Book of Kells

The Guinness Storehouse is the first factory of the Guinness company, and now is a museum of the 250 years of a pint of this beer.

Other area of Dublin is Temple Bar and near there is Christ Church Cathedral and Dublinia

The most important railway in Dublin is DART
