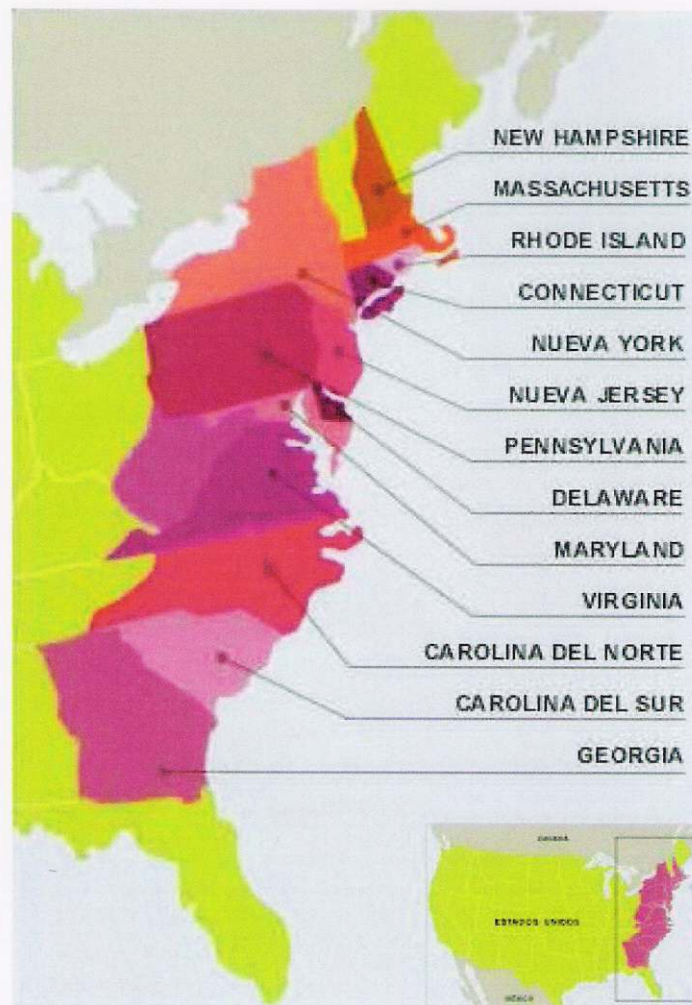


A few years later thirteen colonies were established by the British along the North America Atlantic coast, the French took up the actual French Waianae and Louisianan. The Dutch wrote down in the New Amsterdam, the current New York in the Dutch Waianae and in some Caribbean Islands.



In the colonization process, there were too German, Swedish, Danish and Russian people, but they didn't have great importance.
